West Carrollton School District COVID-19 Guidelines effective 2/22/22

As of February 22nd, 2022 West Carrollton Schools will no longer require masks for students or staff. It will also no longer require quarantine for COVID-19 **exposures** happening inside or outside of the school setting. Students should be monitored daily for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19, regardless of exposure or vaccination status. If signs or symptoms are present, please keep your student home and notify your school's nurse.

Isolation Requirements

Any student who tests positive for COVID-19 will be required to isolate from school for 10 days. Dates will be determined by your school's nurse. The parent or guardian must provide written documentation of the positive test result. With this documentation your student will be allowed to make up any missed work and will not have any COVID-19 related absences counted against his or her attendance.

Sports and Extracurricular Activities

We currently are following the Ohio Department of Health "Test to Play" guidelines for school sponsored extracurricular or sports activities when there is a positive case reported. Students exposed during these activities will be allowed to continue to come to class regardless of vaccination status as long as they remain symptom free.

Ability to continue to participate in the activity will be determined as follows:

- Properly vaccinated students or students with proof of a positive COVID-19 test within the past 90 days will be allowed to continue to participate without testing as long as they remain symptom free.
- Unvaccinated or improperly vaccinated students have a choice to quarantine from play or "test to play".
- If an unvaccinated or improperly vaccinated student chooses "test to play" they must provide proof of a negative test within 24 hours of notification. They will also be required to provide a second test result on day 5-7 after exposure to continue to participate. Dates for the required tests will be provided by a District Nurse. Test results must be submitted to the District Nurse before return to participation is granted.

Testing

If you need a COVID-19 test kit for your student please notify your school's nurse. Proctored testing kits are available for students if needed. Over-the-counter home test results are not acceptable.
